- ⇒ Draft “Study Buddy” mentorship program handbook for students of immigrant families with intent to operationalize before start of student summer break in 2023.

- ⇒ Obtain sustainable resources including revenue streams from sponsors for the information resources artifacts developed inhouse.
- ⇒ Seek out volunteers to carry out the mission of the mentorship programs.
- ⇒ Develop Sponsor Circle Program for Afghans.
